I'm building a simple 7 Segment LED display, using a 74HC595. This chip requires a set of 3 resistors (R1, R2, R3) in order to operate (the datasheet) but I'm wondering whether I should add any pullup/pulldown resistors on those lines. In the example they use +12V for the input, which would lead to me having resistors set to 0.1 or so (for a pullup/pulldown), with the LED's needing around 6mA. Do I need to add pullup/pulldown resistors? I assume not, but I'm always concerned with it making a bit more work, and I don't see how it could be an issue. A: Here is a good read: 82157476af
